Looked after Children (LAC) care leavers 14-16 and LLDD

Hartlepool College of Further Education, has a structured transition programme for vulnerable learners which includes those with an Education, Health and Care plan as well as other students with learning needs and disabilities. The transition programme ensures that learners identified have the correct circle of support in place before they start on their learning journey at college.

A dedicated member of the learning support team, SENDCo and the WARMS team are involved in preparations for college life and monitoring from the day of enrolment. They work closely with professionals (such as the local authority SEN Officers) outside of college and parents/carers to ensure that vulnerable learners are safe and have the correct support in place.

The learning support staff liaise regularly with the WARMS team to ensure update information is shared so that support can be reviewed as and when necessary.
