### Level 3

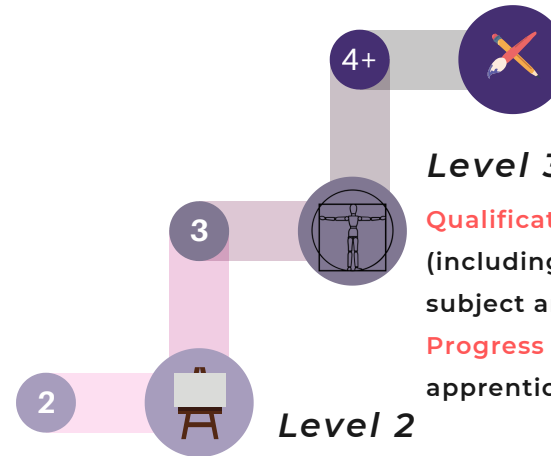
**Qualifications Needed:** 4-5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above (including maths and English), or Level 2 qualification in subject area
