# CACHE L2 EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE

- 1 year full-time programme
- Mainly college based but placement is part of the programme
- Placements are usually in an older person's care setting either a care home or day centre
- DBS check must be completed
- Entry criteria:
- 5 GCSE grades at least 2 at grade 4, one of which must be English or Maths and also at least 3 at grade 3.
- Uniform is a black college polo shirt, black trousers, black shoes.

## UNITS COVERED & BRIEF CONTENT

All units require that you empathise with service users, meaning you try to put yourself in their position. To support students with this we use case studies of service users to get them used to different scenarios and help them to think 'what would I do?' and 'how would I feel?'.

#### **CASE STUDY**

Mary is 65 years old and is married to Norman with whom she lives with. She has vascular dementia which causes her to have short-term memory problems, mobility problems and shuffling are making it hard for her to perform day-to-day activities. This means she is becoming more reliant on Norman. Recently Mary has become incontinent and her behaviour is increasingly becoming more inappropriate and out of character which Norman finds very embarrassing, so he prefers to stay at home with Mary whenever he can rather than take her out. Norman is very worried how he is going to cope as her vascular dementia progresses.

- 1. Describe how do you think having vascular dementia makes Mary feel?
- 2. Norman now cares for Mary. What impact do you think this could have upon Norman and also his relationship with Mary?
- **3.** Research any professionals or organisations that you think could help Mary and Norman, explaining what they could do to help.
- **4.** Mary has vascular dementia, can you find the name of 3 other types of dementia?

#### TASK:

Using the case study provided answer the following questions. Remember empathy.
